- 3** You might pray a daily prayer like this: God, you are faithful through all generations. We pray for Resurrection's youth and children. Bless them and help us to bless them and to help them grow in their faith. Help me to do my part to create meaningful spaces for them. In Jesus name I pray, Amen.
