## TALK

If someone messes up or hurts your feelings, you can choose to forgive them instead of staying upset. It doesn't mean that you let someone keep hurting you (you should talk to a grown-up if that happens). Forgiveness is a choice we can make that changes everything! It frees us from feeling bitter and thinking about it all the time. We show others what Jesus is like when we forgive one another!
