It takes generosity at every level to make Resurrection's ministry happen. The information here reflects the general levels of giving by households supporting the 2025 Ministry Fund. We've held the budget flat for the last two years, yet the cost of ministry has gone up in nearly every area: programs and ministries, missions, utilities, salaries, benefits, are all increasing.

TAKE THE \$10 CHALLENGE

If you haven't started investing in God's daily ministry through Resurrection, would you start today by making a weekly gift of \$10? If you are a regular giver, would you consider increasing your giving? Find yourself on the giving levels listed and consider stepping up to the next level. Or match the \$10 challenge by increasing your current giving by \$10 each week. If, on average, we saw an increase from each family of \$520 per year, we'd cover the increased expenses on the Ministry Fund budget.

GIVE THANKS FOR WHAT YOU HAVE

Gratitude is the foundation of generosity. What five things do you want to thank God for right now? Pause for a moment and under your breath say "Thank you God for..."

LIVE PURPOSEFULLY

Name one dream you have for the church. Thank God for using your generosity to be a part of making a difference. Prayerfully consider increasing your commitment from last year as you're able.

PRACTICE GENEROSITY WITH JOY

When generosity becomes a way of life, it shapes your heart and deepens your trust in God. Make a plan, establish a consistent giving pattern, through recurring gifts or giving intentional practices, and discover the joy of making generosity part of your everyday walk with Christ.
