## TALK

- When is a good time for us to read the Bible together at home?

## DO TOGETHER

Make special bookmarks together to remind your family that the Bible teaches us the very best things! Cut out bookmark shapes from paper or use craft sticks. Decorate them with crayons, stickers, or stamps. On each bookmark, help your child draw or write something they learned about God—like a heart for “God loves me,” a cross for “Jesus saves us,” a Bible for “God’s Word is true,” or happy faces for “God made us.” When you’re finished, place the bookmarks in your family Bible or your child’s favorite books. As you put each one in, talk about how the Bible is the most special book of all and helps us learn about Jesus and how much He loves us!
