Jesus cares for everyone, and He wants us to care for others too!

Talk through these questions as a family:

- Who is someone Jesus would want us to notice and care about this week?
- Who are some people we see every day that Jesus cares about? How can we show them kindness?
- When have you seen someone show care or kindness to another person?
- What is one way our family can care for someone this week?

DO TOGETHER

Try a "Hats Off Kindness Challenge." Write a few simple acts of kindness on small slips of paper (like help someone clean up, say something encouraging, or invite someone to play). Place the slips in a hat, bowl, or cup. Each day, have a family member draw one slip and complete that act of kindness during the day. At the end of the day, talk together about how it went and how it felt to care for someone else. End with a short prayer thanking Jesus for caring for everyone and helping us show that same care to others.
