TALK

God has invited us on the amazing adventure of being part of His kingdom. Talk through these questions:

- How can you help God's kingdom grow?
- How does it feel to know Jesus made a way for you to be part of God's kingdom?
- What are some things that distract you from making God's kingdom important?
- What can you do to love God's kingdom this week?

DO TOGETHER

As a family come up with 5-7 people that are part of God's kingdom (ex. your teacher, your friend, the mail carrier, etc.). Write each of them down on a separate piece of paper. Put all the pieces of paper in a jar.

Each day pick a different piece out of the jar and pray for them as a family. Bonus activity: come with a way your family can show love to this person.

TALK

I can be a part of God's kingdom, and I can live like Jesus every day! Talk through these questions as a family:

- Who is someone you can include or invite to play or spend time with this week?
- What does it look like to live the way Jesus teaches us...showing love, kindness, and forgiveness?
- When have you seen someone make a good choice that reflects God's kingdom?
- What is one way our family can live like we are part of God's kingdom this week?

DO TOGETHER

Try a "Kingdom in Action Chart." On a piece of paper, draw a simple chart with each family member's name and space for a few days of the week. Talk together about what it means to be part of God's kingdom—showing love, helping others, and making good choices. Each day, when someone does something that reflects God's kingdom, add a sticker, checkmark, or draw a small picture in their space. At the end of the week, look back at all the ways your family lived like part of God's kingdom and celebrate together. End with a short prayer thanking God for helping your family live His way.
