DO TOGETHER

Grab a big piece of paper trace the hands of each family member on it. On each hand, draw or write one way you can use your hands to grow God's kingdom. Spend time afterwards as a family discussing the gifts that God has given each of you. Tape the paper somewhere you can all see as a reminder that you can use what God has given you to help others.

DO TOGETHER

Try a "Grow God's Kingdom" activity. Give each family member a small cup, soil, and a few seeds. As you plant them, talk about how Jesus teaches us to grow good things in our hearts—like kindness, forgiveness, and faithfulness. Each day, water your plant and share one way you used what God gave you or showed forgiveness to someone. As the plants grow, celebrate how your family is growing God's kingdom too.
